

## Week 1

Today is our first week of our 1 year prayer time! May God change S. forever because of our prayers for His glory! Below is what we have felt led to pray for today but we want you to pray however you feel God leading you. You can join us in the same thing or go in a different direction.

This week we are praying for an "open heaven". What this means is that we have direct access to God and then God responds to us and commands things to happen as a result of our prayers. The passage in Daniel came to mind when he prayed to the Lord and the "one having the appearance of a man" came to him but was held 21 days (see below).

Daniel 10:10-14

And behold, a hand touched me and set me trembling on my hands and knees. 11 And he said to me, "O Daniel, man greatly loved, understand the words that I speak to you, and stand upright, for now I have been sent to you." And when he had spoken this word to me, I stood up trembling. 12 Then he said to me, "Fear not, Daniel, for from the first day that you set your heart to understand and humbled yourself before your God, your words have been heard, and I have come because of your words. 13 The prince of the kingdom of Persia withstood me twenty-one days, but Michael, one of the chief princes, came to help me, for I was left there with the kings of Persia, 14 and came to make you understand what is to happen to your people in the latter days. For the vision is for days yet to come."

What we felt that we should pray and sing about is heaven being free to come down, all the plans God has to bless S. to be released and that anything hindering Jesus from being able to reveal Himself in S. to be removed.

## Week 2

That would encounter the living God and receive His invitation. Pray that God would "pass out" his invitation to many in S. and that they would truly understand what He is inviting them too.

Matthew 22:1-10

And again Jesus spoke to them in parables, saying, 2 "The kingdom of heaven may be compared to a king who gave a wedding feast for his son, 3 and sent his servants to call those who were invited to the wedding feast, but they would not come. 4 Again he sent other servants, saying, 'Tell those who are invited, See, I have prepared my dinner, my oxen and my fat calves have been slaughtered, and everything is ready. Come to the wedding feast.' 5 But they paid no attention and went off, one to his

farm, another to his business, 6 while the rest seized his servants, treated them shamefully, and killed them. 7 The king was angry, and he sent his troops and destroyed those murderers and burned their city. 8 Then he said to his servants, 'The wedding feast is ready, but those invited were not worthy. 9 Go therefore to the main roads and invite to the wedding feast as many as you find.' 10 And those servants went out into the roads and gathered all whom they found, both bad and good. So the wedding hall was filled with guests.

### **Week 4 & 5**

This week the Lord wants us to “usher in his presence” into S. not just with song but with dance and shouting. (We realize that not everyone may feel comfortable with both so we are going to make this 2 weeks and you can do one each day or spend 2 weeks on one). Two passages came to mind. The first for dancing is when the people of Israel brought the Ark of God to Jerusalem and David danced before the Lord unashamed. The second is when God told Israel to take Jericho. On the last day they were to walk around the city 7 times and then give a big shout! (See the passages below)

We are praying that through our unashamed dancing that we too will usher in God’s presence into S. and through our shouts that we will tear down the “walls” in that place that keep people from knowing Jesus. We pray that God will take back that land and destroy every evil.

#### **Dancing:**

1 Chronicles 15:1-4, 15:25-16:3

David built houses for himself in the city of David. And he prepared a place for the ark of God and pitched a tent for it. 2 Then David said that no one but the Levites may carry the ark of God, for the Lord had chosen them to carry the ark of the Lord and to minister to him forever. 3 And David assembled all Israel at Jerusalem to bring up the ark of the Lord to its place, which he had prepared for it. 4 And David gathered together the sons of Aaron and the Levites:

25 So David and the elders of Israel and the commanders of thousands went to bring up the ark of the covenant of the Lord from the house of Obed-edom with rejoicing. 26 And because God helped the Levites who were carrying the ark of the covenant of the Lord, they sacrificed seven bulls and seven rams. 27 David was clothed with a robe of fine linen, as also were all the Levites who were carrying the ark, and the singers and Chenaniah the leader of the music of the singers. And David wore a linen ephod. 28 So all Israel brought up the ark of the covenant of the Lord with shouting, to the sound of the horn, trumpets, and cymbals, and made loud music on harps and lyres.

29 And as the ark of the covenant of the Lord came to the city of David, Michal the daughter of Saul looked out of the window and saw King David dancing and rejoicing, and she despised him in her heart.

### **Shouting:**

Joshua 6:1-20

Now Jericho was shut up inside and outside because of the people of Israel. None went out, and none came in. 2 And the Lord said to Joshua, "See, I have given Jericho into your hand, with its king and mighty men of valor. 3 You shall march around the city, all the men of war going around the city once. Thus shall you do for six days. 4 Seven priests shall bear seven trumpets of rams' horns before the ark. On the seventh day you shall march around the city seven times, and the priests shall blow the trumpets. 5 And when they make a long blast with the ram's horn, when you hear the sound of the trumpet, then all the people shall shout with a great shout, and the wall of the city will fall down flat, and the people shall go up, everyone straight before him." 6 So Joshua the son of Nun called the priests and said to them, "Take up the ark of the covenant and let seven priests bear seven trumpets of rams' horns before the ark of the Lord." 7 And he said to the people, "Go forward. March around the city and let the armed men pass on before the ark of the Lord."

8 And just as Joshua had commanded the people, the seven priests bearing the seven trumpets of rams' horns before the Lord went forward, blowing the trumpets, with the ark of the covenant of the Lord following them. 9 The armed men were walking before the priests who were blowing the trumpets, and the rear guard was walking after the ark, while the trumpets blew continually. 10 But Joshua commanded the people, "You shall not shout or make your voice heard, neither shall any word go out of your mouth, until the day I tell you to shout. Then you shall shout." 11 So he caused the ark of the Lord to circle the city, going about it once. And they came into the camp and spent the night in the camp.

12 Then Joshua rose early in the morning, and the priests took up the ark of the Lord. 13 And the seven priests bearing the seven trumpets of rams' horns before the ark of the Lord walked on, and they blew the trumpets continually. And the armed men were walking before them, and the rear guard was walking after the ark of the Lord, while the trumpets blew continually. 14 And the second day they marched around the city once, and returned into the camp. So they did for six days.

15 On the seventh day they rose early, at the dawn of day, and marched around the city in the same manner seven times. It was only on that day that they marched around the city seven times. 16 And at the seventh time, when the priests had blown the trumpets, Joshua said to the people, "Shout, for the Lord has given you the city. 17 And the city and all that is within it shall be devoted to the Lord for destruction. Only Rahab the prostitute and all who are with her in her house shall live, because she hid the messengers whom we sent. 18 But you, keep yourselves from the things devoted to destruction, lest when you have devoted them you take any of the devoted things and make the camp of Israel a thing for destruction and bring trouble upon it. 19 But all silver and gold, and every vessel of bronze and iron, are holy to the Lord; they shall go into the treasury of the Lord." 20 So the people shouted, and the trumpets were blown. As soon as the people heard the sound of the trumpet, the people shouted a great shout, and the wall fell down flat, so that the people went up into the city, every man straight before him, and they captured the city.

## **Week 8 & 9**

Right now in S. evil appears to have free reign-violence, bloodshed, starvation etc. But we do not fix our eyes on what is seen but remember the victory is the Lord's and that is why what we are praying this week and next is crucial! We are praying for breakthrough! Elijah found himself in a battle alone against 450 Baal prophets but he had all that was needed-God! S. also has roots in Baal worship. Even today there remains a Baal Temple and political leaders have been known to have used Satanic practices. All this to say that we need to pray that God reveals Himself as Lord and more powerful than any evil force! Show your power Lord!

Elijah also was in a land that was in desperate need of rain. The land and people were crying out for water. Once the evil was brought down God brought the rain. The rain was a sign of breakthrough! We are going to pray that God would bring physical rain as a sign of spiritual rain-cleansing, refreshing, quenching.

1 Kings 18:20-46

So Ahab sent to all the people of Israel and gathered the prophets together at Mount Carmel. 21 And Elijah came near to all the people and said, "How long will you go limping between two different opinions? If the Lord is God, follow him; but if Baal, then follow him." And the people did not answer him a word. 22 Then Elijah said to the people, "I, even I only, am left a prophet of the Lord, but Baal's prophets are 450 men. 23 Let two bulls be given to us, and let them choose one bull for themselves and cut it in pieces and lay it on the wood, but put no fire to it. And I will prepare the other bull and lay it on the wood and put no fire to it. 24 And you call upon the name of your god, and I will call upon the name of the Lord, and the God who answers by fire, he is God." And all the people answered, "It is well spoken." 25 Then Elijah said to the prophets of Baal, "Choose for yourselves one bull and prepare it first, for you are many, and call upon the name of your god, but put no fire to it." 26 And they took the bull that was given them, and they prepared it and called upon the name of Baal from morning until noon, saying, "O Baal, answer us!" But there was no voice, and no one answered. And they limped around the altar that they had made. 27 And at noon Elijah mocked them, saying, "Cry aloud, for he is a god. Either he is musing, or he is relieving himself, or he is on a journey, or perhaps he is asleep and must be awakened." 28 And they cried aloud and cut themselves after their custom with swords and lances, until the blood gushed out upon them. 29 And as midday passed, they raved on until the time of the offering of the oblation, but there was no voice. No one answered; no one paid attention.

30 Then Elijah said to all the people, "Come near to me." And all the people came near to him. And he repaired the altar of the Lord that had been thrown down. 31 Elijah took twelve stones, according to the number of the tribes of the sons of Jacob, to whom the word of the Lord came, saying, "Israel shall be your name," 32 and with the stones he built an altar in the name of the Lord. And he made a trench about the altar, as great as would contain two seahs of seed. 33 And he put the wood in order and cut the bull in pieces and laid it on the wood. And he said, "Fill four jars with water and pour it on the burnt offering and on the wood." 34 And he said, "Do it a second time." And they did it a second time. And he said, "Do it a third time." And they did it a third time. 35 And the water ran around the altar and filled the trench also with water.

36 And at the time of the offering of the oblation, Elijah the prophet came near and said, "O Lord, God of Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, let it be known this day that you are God in Israel, and that I am your servant, and that I have done all these things at your word. 37 Answer me, O Lord, answer me, that this people may know that you, O Lord, are God, and that you have turned their hearts back." 38 Then the fire of the Lord fell and consumed the burnt offering and the wood and the stones and the dust, and licked up the water that was in the trench. 39 And when all the people saw it, they fell on their faces and said, "The Lord, he is God; the Lord, he is God." 40 And Elijah said to them, "Seize the prophets of Baal; let not one of them escape." And they seized them. And Elijah brought them down to the brook Kishon and slaughtered them there.

41 And Elijah said to Ahab, "Go up, eat and drink, for there is a sound of the rushing of rain." 42 So Ahab went up to eat and to drink. And Elijah went up to the top of Mount Carmel. And he bowed himself down on the earth and put his face between his knees. 43 And he said to his servant, "Go up now, look toward the sea." And he went up and looked and said, "There is nothing." And he said, "Go again," seven times. 44 And at the seventh time he said, "Behold, a little cloud like a man's hand is rising from the sea." And he said, "Go up, say to Ahab, 'Prepare your chariot and go down, lest the rain stop you.'" 45 And in a little while the heavens grew black with clouds and wind, and there was a great rain. And Ahab rode and went to Jezreel. 46 And the hand of the Lord was on Elijah, and he gathered up his garment and ran before Ahab to the entrance of Jezreel.

## **Week 10**

This week we going to pray for complete restoration! In Isaiah 61 we see God taking the negative and restoring them-making things new. We want to speak these verses over S. and sing this new restoration into being! We also want to ask God if there are other names that God wants to tear down and what new names he wants to give S. Basically we want to tear down curses and bring forth blessings! For example: We speak over S. "the oil of gladness" instead of "mourning".

Isaiah 61:1-11

The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me, because the Lord has anointed me  
to bring good news to the poor; he has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted,  
to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound;  
2 to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor, and the day of vengeance of our God;  
to comfort all who mourn;  
3 to grant to those who mourn in Zion— to give them a beautiful headdress instead of ashes,  
the oil of gladness instead of mourning, the garment of praise instead of a faint spirit;  
that they may be called oaks of righteousness, the planting of the Lord, that he may be glorified.  
4 They shall build up the ancient ruins; they shall raise up the former devastations;  
they shall repair the ruined cities, the devastations of many generations.  
5 Strangers shall stand and tend your flocks; foreigners shall be your plowmen and vinedressers;  
6 but you shall be called the priests of the Lord; they shall speak of you as the ministers of our God;  
you shall eat the wealth of the nations, and in their glory you shall boast.  
7 Instead of your shame there shall be a double portion; instead of dishonor they shall rejoice in their  
lot;  
therefore in their land they shall possess a double portion; they shall have everlasting joy.  
8 For I the Lord love justice; I hate robbery and wrong;  
I will faithfully give them their recompense, and I will make an everlasting covenant with them.  
9 Their offspring shall be known among the nations, and their descendants in the midst of the peoples;  
all who see them shall acknowledge them, that they are an offspring the Lord has blessed.  
6 I will greatly rejoice in the Lord; my soul shall exult in my God,  
for he has clothed me with the garments of salvation; he has covered me with the robe of  
righteousness, as a bridegroom decks himself like a priest with a beautiful headdress,  
and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels.  
11 For as the earth brings forth its sprouts, and as a garden causes what is sown in it to sprout up,  
so the Lord God will cause righteousness and praise to sprout up before all the nations.

## Week 12

This week we are going to worship the Creator! God created the heavens and the earth out of NOTHING! A speaker once said that “when we are sitting on a pile of nothing (feeling like nothing is changing in the situation) that we have the raw materials God uses to create”. Out of nothing He creates. Today we want to join God in asking Him to create new things in S. out of the piles of nothing there. We are going to praise Him as creator on S’s behalf and we are going to join God in these new creations that he wants to bring by drawing, sculpting, painting etc.

We have been humbled by how God allows us to join Him in His creative process. God is the one who created the earth and all in it but he allowed man to name it. In a similar way it is God who will bring things to pass in S. but we are joining him by expressing it in a creative way. We are dreaming with God of what could be in the future. In Isaiah 42:9 God says that he is doing a new thing and before it happens he tells us about it. Pray that God will show you something He wants to create in S. and then agree with him by drawing, sculpting, or painting it.

Isaiah 42:1-9

The Lord's Chosen Servant

42 Behold my servant, whom I uphold,  
my chosen, in whom my soul delights;  
I have put my Spirit upon him;  
he will bring forth justice to the nations.  
2 He will not cry aloud or lift up his voice,  
or make it heard in the street;  
3 a bruised reed he will not break,  
and a faintly burning wick he will not quench;  
he will faithfully bring forth justice.  
4 He will not grow faint or be discouraged  
till he has established justice in the earth;  
and the coastlands wait for his law.

5 Thus says God, the Lord,  
who created the heavens and stretched them out,  
who spread out the earth and what comes from it,  
who gives breath to the people on it  
and spirit to those who walk in it:  
6 "I am the Lord; I have called you in righteousness;  
I will take you by the hand and keep you;  
I will give you as a covenant for the people,  
a light for the nations,  
7 to open the eyes that are blind,  
to bring out the prisoners from the dungeon,  
from the prison those who sit in darkness.

8 I am the Lord; that is my name;  
my glory I give to no other,  
nor my praise to carved idols.



9 Behold, the former things have come to pass,  
and new things I now declare;  
before they spring forth  
I tell you of them."

Exodus 14:13-20

And Moses said to the people, "Fear not, stand firm, and see the salvation of the Lord, which he will work for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall never see again. 14 The Lord will fight for you, and you have only to be silent."

15 The Lord said to Moses, "Why do you cry to me? Tell the people of Israel to go forward. 16 Lift up your staff, and stretch out your hand over the sea and divide it, that the people of Israel may go through the sea on dry ground. 17 And I will harden the hearts of the Egyptians so that they shall go in after them, and I will get glory over Pharaoh and all his host, his chariots, and his horsemen. 18 And the Egyptians shall know that I am the Lord, when I have gotten glory over Pharaoh, his chariots, and his horsemen."

19 Then the angel of God who was going before the host of Israel moved and went behind them, and the pillar of cloud moved from before them and stood behind them, 20 coming between the host of Egypt and the host of Israel. And there was the cloud and the darkness.

## **Week 20**

This week we are praying for those who have the light of Jesus in them that they would shine brightly. We are praying for the presence of God to be with them and to increase their light. (We have heard of many S's coming to know Jesus during the crisis although we cannot independently verify this). We also want to call out more to leave darkness and come into the light. We want to say from Ephesians 5:14 "Awake, O sleeper, and arise from the dead, and Christ will shine on you."

We also want to pray into this picture from one of our prayers:

"As I was praying this morning, in my mind I was looking at S. and there was nothing but darkness. I could sense millions of faint lights; I could not see anything, but I knew they were there. It was as though each one felt it was all alone and was afraid to let anyone know it was there because it felt it could not overcome the darkness by itself and would be swallowed up by it. But then, very slowly, I began to see

them; just a couple of dim twinkles at first, but as they began to see the light from one another they grew stronger and brighter, being encouraged by each other's light. And then there were more and more lights coming faster and faster until suddenly the light had completely broken through and there was no more darkness.

It is my hope and prayer for S. that His lights would begin to shine in the darkness and that they would be encouraged and strengthened by one another and know that in His power and righteousness they can overcome the darkness and will no longer be afraid to be seen."

## Week 25

The first aspect of prayer is to pray for those that have found themselves in the desert place- that Jesus would meet them there. God has used the desert in many Biblical stories. Moses and the Israelites wandered in the desert. To them the desert was a place of testing. John the Baptist found himself in the desert-calling others out of a life of complacency and preparing the way for the Savior to come. Pray that the S. desert (or wilderness) experience would draw them to Jesus through either one, testing their own faith or two, hearing the call to follow Jesus. In Jeremiah, we again see the Israelites in the desert because of their disobedience. It has caused them to be defeated by their enemies. But God has promised them that a day will come that he will bring them back to their land. We have felt lead to pray through some of these verses for the S-ians that are living in other nations. Speak these verses over the refugees (change Israel for S.).

Let it be known to you therefore, brothers, that through this man forgiveness of sins is proclaimed to you, and by him everyone who believes is freed from everything 39 from which you could not be freed by the law of Moses.

### Ephesians 1:7-10

In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace, 8 which he lavished upon us, in all wisdom and insight 9 making known to us the mystery of his will, according to his purpose, which he set forth in Christ 10 as a plan for the fullness of time, to unite all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth.

## Week 35

This week we want to pray that God would bring healing to all the hurts and suffering that the war has caused. That could mean forgiving the S. gov't, or the person that killed their relative or stole the items in their house or the neighbor that is now taking advantage of them and charging them high rent, or a hundred other reasons. The next two days we want to pray for the S-ians to be able to forgive those that have hurt them and we feel that to be able to do that they need to (1) know the forgiveness that Jesus gives us (yesterday) and (2) know the healing power of Jesus. So today we are going to pray that God would heal their emotional and spiritual pain. And then tomorrow we will pray that God will give them His strength to forgive those that have done these evil things. \*We have found ourselves having to practice forgiving as we see our friends suffering. Pray also for those that are doing the evil, Pray that they would know that Jesus' forgiveness and healing extends even to them and that they would be able to forgive themselves.

Pray that those suffering would know that deep healing power of Jesus. Pray that Jesus would bring healing to their hearts and that they would know His comfort. \*Today we are focusing on spiritual, emotional and mental healing, in a few days we will pray for physical healing as well.

Speak these passages over S.

Jeremiah 33:6-9

Behold, I will bring to it health and healing, and I will heal them and reveal to them abundance of prosperity and security. 7 I will restore the fortunes of [S], and rebuild them as they were at first. 8 I will cleanse them from all the guilt of their sin against me, and I will forgive all the guilt of their sin and rebellion against me. 9 And this city shall be to me a name of joy, a praise and a glory before all the nations of the earth who shall hear of all the good that I do for them. They shall fear and tremble because of all the good and all the prosperity I provide for it.

### **Week 37**

## **Week 38**

This week we are going to pray for miraculous physical health and healing! Many people have been injured because of the war; many of these injuries have lasting effects. In addition, due to the overcrowding of areas (like the refugee camps for instance) there is a significant rise in dysentery and communicable disease (like Measles, TB and polio). Pray that many would encounter Jesus and experience His healing power. Pray that God would protect them from sickness. Pray that Jesus would visit them in their very difficult situations in the camps. Pray that God would bring His supernatural health to all places with S-ians and free them from sickness and that they would know Him as the Great Physician.

We are praying for physical health and healing to draw them to Jesus so that they can have spiritual healing as well. We want to proclaim that "healing is coming". In Jesus' ministry he cared for the whole person but he also used healings to draw people to God. He restored the physical to show that the Kingdom of God had come.

We are also praying for a deep desire to be healed and that in that way they would invite and call out to Jesus.

Mark 2:1-12

“And when he returned to Capernaum after some days, it was reported that he was at home. 2 And many were gathered together, so that there was no more room, not even at the door. And he was preaching the word to them. 3 And they came, bringing to him a paralytic carried by four men. 4 And when they could not get near him because of the crowd, they removed the roof above him, and when they had made an opening, they let down the bed on which the paralytic lay. 5 And when Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralytic, "My son, your sins are forgiven." 6 Now some of the scribes were sitting there, questioning in their hearts, 7 "Why does this man speak like that? He is blaspheming! Who can forgive sins but God alone?" 8 And immediately Jesus, perceiving in his spirit that they thus questioned within themselves, said to them, "Why do you question these things in your hearts? 9 Which is easier, to say to the paralytic, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Rise, take up your bed and walk'? 10 But that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins"—he said to the paralytic— 11 "I say to you, rise, pick up your bed, and go home." 12 And he rose and immediately picked up his bed and went out before them all, so that they were all amazed and glorified God, saying, "We never saw anything like this!"

## Week 40

This week we are going to cry out like the persistent widow for justice in S. And tomorrow we will cry out for mercy. Justice and Mercy go together, we want both in S. We want justice against the oppression and evil but we also want mercy for the innocent and the repentant. Isaiah 30 talks about God's mercy and justice. (See tomorrow for the first part of the verse). The last part (see below) talks about God's justice on the people of Assyria. We are praying with this verse that God would "fight with them" -the evil forces and that the "king" of S. (Satan) would go to his burning place. We know that our battle is spiritual but we also pray that God would save evil men and if they are unwilling to repent that he would take them out. We pray this for those in authority in S. –those who have a God given responsibility to administer justice.

Luke 18:1-8

The Parable of the Persistent Widow

18 And he told them a parable to the effect that they ought always to pray and not lose heart. 2 He said, "In a certain city there was a judge who neither feared God nor respected man. 3 And there was a widow in that city who kept coming to him and saying, 'Give me justice against my adversary.' 4 For a while he refused, but afterward he said to himself, 'Though I neither fear God nor respect man, 5 yet because this widow keeps bothering me, I will give her justice, so that she will not beat me down by her continual coming.'" 6 And the Lord said, "Hear what the unrighteous judge says. 7 And will not God give justice to his elect, who cry to him day and night? Will he delay long over them? 8 I tell you, he will give justice to them speedily. Nevertheless, when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on earth?"

## **Week 41**

This week we cry out for mercy on S. and for an end to the bloodshed. Muslims know God to be merciful. Pray that they would know the full extent of his mercy-not just his mercy in this situation but for eternity. Pray that the mercy he pours out during this time would lead them to the mercy of the cross. Pray also that they would know God's justice as well - Jesus' death and God's mercy are so significant only in light of his justice and demand for payment of sin. Pray that they would know His justice so that they could understand His mercy. Pray these verses below over them.

Isaiah 30:18

Therefore the Lord waits to be gracious to you,  
and therefore he exalts himself to show mercy to you.

For the Lord is a God of justice;

blessed are all those who wait for him.

## **Week 42**

16 "And in that day, declares the Lord, you will call me 'My Husband,' and no longer will you call me 'My Baal.' 17 For I will remove the names of the Baals from her mouth, and they shall be remembered by name no more. 18 And I will make for them a covenant on that day with the beasts of the field, the birds of the heavens, and the creeping things of the ground. And I will abolish the bow, the sword, and war from the land, and I will make you lie down in safety. 19 And I will betroth you to me forever. I will betroth you to me in righteousness and in justice, in steadfast love and in mercy. 20 I will betroth you to me in faithfulness. And you shall know the Lord.

21 "And in that day I will answer, declares the Lord, I will answer the heavens, and they shall answer the earth,

22 and the earth shall answer the grain, the wine, and the oil, and they shall answer Jezreel,

23 and I will sow her for myself in the land.

And I will have mercy on No Mercy, and I will say to Not My People, 'You are my people'; and he shall say, 'You are my God.'"

## **Week 43**

This week we are going to pray that the S. people would put their confidence and trust in the Lord. Just like yesterday we prayed about those that were trying to provide for themselves. We want to pray that

they would trust in the Lord, sit back and watch him fight/provide for them! Below is a story about an Assyrian king trying to attack God's people. They put their confidence in the Lord and saw God give them the victory! Also this king saw himself as one that no one could come against. Satan thinks that he is winning in S. but our God is greater!

Pray that God would do a similar thing in places that are surrounded throughout S. Pray that those that are surrounded would find their confidence in the Lord and that he would come to their aid.

#### 2 Chronicles 32:1-23

After these things and these acts of faithfulness, Sennacherib king of Assyria came and invaded Judah and encamped against the fortified cities, thinking to win them for himself. 2 And when Hezekiah saw that Sennacherib had come and intended to fight against Jerusalem, 3 he planned with his officers and his mighty men to stop the water of the springs that were outside the city; and they helped him. 4 A great many people were gathered, and they stopped all the springs and the brook that flowed through the land, saying, "Why should the kings of Assyria come and find much water?" 5 He set to work resolutely and built up all the wall that was broken down and raised towers upon it, and outside it he built another wall, and he strengthened the Millo in the city of David. He also made weapons and shields in abundance. 6 And he set combat commanders over the people and gathered them together to him in the square at the gate of the city and spoke encouragingly to them, saying, 7 "Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or dismayed before the king of Assyria and all the horde that is with him, for there are more with us than with him. 8 With him is an arm of flesh, but with us is the Lord our God, to help us and to fight our battles." And the people took confidence from the words of Hezekiah king of Judah.

#### Sennacherib Blasphemes

9 After this, Sennacherib, king of Assyria, who was besieging Lachish with all his forces, sent his servants to Jerusalem to Hezekiah king of Judah and to all the people of Judah who were in Jerusalem, saying, 10 "Thus says Sennacherib king of Assyria, 'On what are you trusting, that you endure the siege in Jerusalem? 11 Is not Hezekiah misleading you, that he may give you over to die by famine and by thirst, when he tells you, "The Lord our God will deliver us from the hand of the king of Assyria"? 12 Has not this same Hezekiah taken away his high places and his altars and commanded Judah and Jerusalem, "Before one altar you shall worship, and on it you shall burn your sacrifices"? 13 Do you not know what I and my fathers have done to all the peoples of other lands? Were the gods of the nations of those lands at all able to deliver their lands out of my hand? 14 Who among all the gods of those nations that my fathers devoted to destruction was able to deliver his people from my hand, that your God should be able to deliver you from my hand? 15 Now, therefore, do not let Hezekiah deceive you or mislead you in this fashion, and do not believe him, for no god of any nation or kingdom has been able to deliver his people from my hand or from the hand of my fathers. How much less will your God deliver you out of my hand!'"

16 And his servants said still more against the Lord God and against his servant Hezekiah. 17 And he wrote letters to cast contempt on the Lord, the God of Israel and to speak against him, saying, "Like the gods of the nations of the lands who have not delivered their people from my hands, so the God of Hezekiah will not deliver his people from my hand." 18 And they shouted it with a loud voice in the language of Judah to the people of Jerusalem who were on the wall, to frighten and terrify them, in order that they might take the city. 19 And they spoke of the God of Jerusalem as they spoke of the gods of the peoples of the earth, which are the work of men's hands.

## The Lord Delivers Jerusalem

20 Then Hezekiah the king and Isaiah the prophet, the son of Amoz, prayed because of this and cried to heaven. 21 And the Lord sent an angel, who cut off all the mighty warriors and commanders and officers in the camp of the king of Assyria. So he returned with shame of face to his own land. And when he came into the house of his god, some of his own sons struck him down there with the sword. 22 So the Lord saved Hezekiah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem from the hand of Sennacherib king of Assyria and from the hand of all his enemies, and he provided for them on every side. 23 And many brought gifts to the Lord to Jerusalem and precious things to Hezekiah king of Judah, so that he was exalted in the sight of all nations from that time onward.

## Week 45

This week we want to usher in the presence of God in S. We want to ask that he make his presence known in that land! That His presence would “go” with the S. people just like Moses prayed for Israel that God’s presence would remain with them wherever they went. God in Islam is known as one that is not near but far. Pray that God would break through this lie and show them that He is indeed near!

Exodus 33:12-23

Moses' Intercession

12 Moses said to the Lord, "See, you say to me, 'Bring up this people,' but you have not let me know whom you will send with me. Yet you have said, 'I know you by name, and you have also found favor in my sight.' 13 Now therefore, if I have found favor in your sight, please show me now your ways, that I may know you in order to find favor in your sight. Consider too that this nation is your people." 14 And he said, "My presence will go with you, and I will give you rest." 15 And he said to him, "If your presence will not go with me, do not bring us up from here. 16 For how shall it be known that I have found favor in your sight, I and your people? Is it not in your going with us, so that we are distinct, I and your people, from every other people on the face of the earth?"

17 And the Lord said to Moses, "This very thing that you have spoken I will do, for you have found favor in my sight, and I know you by name." 18 Moses said, "Please show me your glory." 19 And he said, "I will make all my goodness pass before you and will proclaim before you my name 'The Lord.' And I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will show mercy on whom I will show mercy. 20 But," he said, "you cannot see my face, for man shall not see me and live." 21 And the Lord said, "Behold, there is a place by me where you shall stand on the rock, 22 and while my glory passes by I will put you in a cleft of the rock, and I will cover you with my hand until I have passed by. 23 Then I will take away my hand, and you shall see my back, but my face shall not be seen."

## Week 47

This week we want to pray for God's glory to be revealed in S. It seems to naturally come once in the presence of God. SO we want to call it out "show your Glory in S." Pray also that God would reveal His glory to the nation as a whole like he did with the nation of Israel when they made a sacrifice to the Lord (see passages below).

Exodus 34:29-35

The Shining Face of Moses

29 When Moses came down from Mount Sinai, with the two tablets of the testimony in his hand as he came down from the mountain, Moses did not know that his face was radiant because he had been talking with God. 30 Aaron and all the people of Israel saw Moses, and behold, his face was radiant, and they were afraid to come near him. 31 But Moses called to them, and Aaron and all the leaders of the congregation returned to him, and Moses talked with them. 32 Afterward all the people of Israel came near, and he commanded them all that the Lord had spoken with him in Mount Sinai. 33 And when Moses had finished speaking with them, he put a veil over his face.

34 Whenever Moses went in before the Lord to speak with him, he would remove the veil, until he came out. And when he came out and told the people of Israel what he was commanded, 35 the people of Israel would see that his face was radiant. And Moses would put the veil over his face again, until he went in to speak with him.

Leviticus 9:23-24

And Moses and Aaron went into the tent of meeting, and when they came out they blessed the people, and the glory of the Lord appeared to all the people. 24 And fire came out from before the Lord and consumed the burnt offering and the pieces of fat on the altar, and when all the people saw it, they shouted and fell on their faces.
